NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

TELEPHONE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED. Entries not on official AKC forms and photocopies of AKC entry forms without "Agreement and Rules" on the reverse side of the entry forms are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

NO ENTRY shall be made and no entry shall be accepted that specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT ENTRY FORM CLEARLY to avoid error. The Rio Grande Obedience Dog Club, Inc. assumes no responsibility for incomplete or inaccurate information on the entry form or for a dog being entered in a class for which he is not eligible.

CHANGES, ADDITIONS OR CORRECTIONS TO ENTRY FORMS must be received in writing by the Trial Secretary, prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED, CANCELED, ALTERED OR SUBSTITUTED after the entries have been closed.

MOVE-UPS (Both Rally and Obedience) ARE ALLOWED: After a dog earns a title, it may be moved up to the next class in a future trial even though the closing date for the trial has passed. This move-up may be requested if, according to the owner's records, the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial. The request for a move-up must be made in writing to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.

THE RIO GRANDE OBEDIENCE DOG CLUB, INC. may decline any entry for cause or may remove any dog on account of sickness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.

ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event of (1) errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, (2) the dog being absent, (3) the dog being disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee, (4) having been entered incorrectly, (5) bitches coming in season.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Rio Grande Obedience Dog Club, Inc. will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in his or her being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

NO ENTRY FEES will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.

A RECORDING FEE OF \$.50 will be required for each dog entered at any show held under the rules of the American Kennel Club. The AKC will also collect a \$3 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in each show.

ALL ENTRIES are to be mailed with Fees to the RGODC Trial Secretary, c/o Florence Dick, 304 Purple Hills Way, El Paso, TX 79912. Entries will not be accepted without fees. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practicable after the closing date. Should such acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time please contact the Trial Secretary.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The club and its committees will not be responsible for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of the dogs in the ring. Dogs need to be at the trial only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging.

THE CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO SUBSTITUTE a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be claimed the day of the trial. None will be mailed.

THE CLUB RESERVES the right to restrict the number of exercise pens per exhibitor and may request that crates be stacked to maximize space available for set-ups. No roping off or reserving of crating area by any method is permitted.

ALL DOGS MUST be kept on leash when not crated or in exercise pens or in the ring.

EXHIBITORS are expected to keep crating and exercising areas clean.

ANY AND ALL DAMAGE caused by the exhibitor will be the sole responsibility of the exhibitor. Parents or guardians will be totally responsible for the actions and safety of their children.

IT IS UNDERSTOOD that the Rio Grande Obedience Dog Club, Inc., will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog from any cause, or for the damage caused by any dog. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care, custody, and control of the handler or owner at all times. Rio Grande Obedience Dog Club, Inc., assumes no responsibility for any damage to property or injury to children.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury, or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of the new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
