



Help Protect Children: Report Sexual Assault Properly



If a child reports to you:

1. Listen, affirm, and thank the child for telling you. Remain **CALM**, and **never blame** the child.



2. Do not pry for details or ask leading questions (i.e. “Did your dad touch you there?”) Such questions may cause a valid case to be dismissed from court.



3. Report the child’s information **IMMEDIATELY** to L.C.P.D. (526-0795), D.A.S.O. (525-1911) or C.Y.F.D. *(1-800-797-3260). You have the choice to

remain anonymous



4. Do not contact the alleged perpetrator of the assault before reporting, nor interfere in the investigation.
5. Feel free to refer the child and/or family to **La Piñon** (526-3437 or 1-888-595-7273)

Remain calm and NEVER blame the child.

Do not pry for details or ask leading questions (i.e. “Did your dad touch you there?”) Such questions may cause a valid case to be dismissed from court.

Report the child’s information **IMMEDIATELY**.
You have the choice to remain anonymous.

Do not contact the alleged perpetrator of the assault before reporting, nor interfere in the investigation.
