Attention Soccer Officials and Coaches,

A number of you have asked for some guidance and clarification regarding the new NMAA misconduct rule. The following seeks to clarify the various components of the rule. I want to emphasize that the ultimate penalties for a D1 or D9 Misconduct will be issued by the NMAA.

New NMAA Soccer Misconduct Rule interpretation and Q&A.

- A. Four components of the revised D9 Misconduct Card. Only one need be present for a D9 to be issued.
 - Players, coaches and team personnel who leave the team area to join or escalate a fight or altercation (D1 misconduct no longer includes coaches or team personnel).
 - 2. Coaches and team personnel who engage in violent conduct against any person.
 - 3. Players who violently escalate a situation at stoppage of play
 - 4. Players who engage in violent conduct (as per definition in NMAA 7.17.3.A.4) against a defenseless opponent (regardless of whether ball is in play or at stoppage)

B. Situational examples/Q&A

- 1. Player A engages in Serious Foul Play. Player B engages in violent conduct as a direct response. Eject both players: A for D3 and B for D9.
- 2. Same as #1 but Player A reacts to Player B's retaliatory aggression with a punch. Eject both players for D9. The retaliatory action is exactly the type of action that has caused benches to clear in the past and is what the new D9 category is trying to prevent.

- 3. Player A engages in violent conduct by head-butting opponent B during stoppage of play. Opponent B walks away from further confrontation. Eject player A for D1 and use the match report to describe in detail the incident. Do not expand D1 to D9 if the incident does not provide a response or escalation.
- 4. Same as #3 but opponent B responds by throwing a punch. Eject both players for D9.
- 5. Same as #3 but both benches empty and various fights ensue. Eject all players and team personnel involved for D9.
- 6. Players A and B battle shoulder to shoulder for a ball. Player B wins the ball and heads upfield. Player A chases after Player B and drags him/her down from behind by the hair and proceeds to kick him/her repeatedly while on the ground. Eject player A for D9.
