

2008 LCHA Western Division Rules & Information

Our rules are based on AQHA rules, but do not strictly conform to them. The rules are as follows:

- The contestant's age on Jan 1st will determine the qualifying age group for the year.
- Stallions are shown under the discretion of the manager.
- Exhibitors will be given a 1 minute gate!
- No refunds will be made after the closing date except in the case of accident or injury.
- LCHA is not responsible for the decisions of any judge. Placings are final.
- LCHA will not be held responsible/liable for accidents or losses of any kind.
- Any protests must be made to the show manager before the next class has finished in order to be considered. Failure to respond in a timely manner will result in the waiving of any and all complaints that may have arisen. The show management has the final decision.
- **Classes with fewer than three entries may be cancelled or combined.**
- Appropriate show attire must be worn, including long sleeves, pants, hat, and boots.
- All entries, including all fees, must be made on LCHA forms and must be completed in their entirety.
- Any horse and/or rider may be excused from the ring if deemed dangerous to themselves or others. This decision is at the sole discretion of the judge and/or show management.
- Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. This is for the safety of the riders and horses.
- Horses that are obvious kickers must have a red ribbon on their tails at all times or they will not be allowed to compete.
- 1st place in each class earns 6 points: 2nd 5 points, 3rd 4 points, etc. If there are more than 6 entries, everyone 7th and below will earn 1 point for the class.
- Riders must compete in 4 of the 5 shows to be eligible for year-end awards. (A double point show counts as 2 shows.)
- The same horse/rider combination may not be cross-entered between canter and non-canter classes in the same show.
- If a rider enters more than one horse at a show, they must designate the horse to count points for the day.
- Junior horse is a horse 5 and under and can be ridden with two hands.
- Senior horse is a horse 6 and over and must be ridden with one hand.
- Championship classes are double point classes and are open (all age groups).
