will be held on Saturday April 14th at the Alumni pond on the NMSU Campus. Last year we had over 120 kids with their parents learning about fish habitat and how to fish. The clinic runs from 9am to about 1pm. We serve pizza around 11:30am with prizes given out to each kid. We need as many volunteers as possible, so if you can help please contact Tom Wobbe or myself. Your service would be much appreciated.

Our April General meeting is on Monday the 9th right after Easter. Our guest speaker will be Bob Widgren who will be talking about fishing for Atlantic salmon in New Brunswick, Canada. He will be covering the famous Miramichin River and the Renous River along with a few others. If we have enough member interest in fishing for Atlantic salmon, we could look into a club trip in the fall of 2013. This is what most of us dream about. MVFF Board Meeting Minutes

Monday, March 19, 2012 Submitted by Jim Sorenson, Secretary

The MVFF Board meeting was called to order at 7:00pm in the NMDG&F Conference Room by President Chuck Mueller. In attendance were Chuck Mueller, Jeff Arteburn, Ron Warnke, Gary Mann, Bob Silver, Jim Sorenson and Ron Bellerose and non-Board member, Jim Hulsey.

- 1. Minutes of the February 2012 Board meeting were approved as published in the newsletter.
- The Treasurer reported that the Club has a balance of \$10,248. The Mabie Scholarship Fund had a market value of \$10,709 as of June 30, 2011. The Treasurer's Report was accepted.
- 3. The Club has 240 paid members.
- 4. Ron Bellerose reported that Ft. Bliss has requested that the Project Healing Waters trips to the Lease be moved from May 16 to May 23 and from October 3 to October 10. Ron will check with Jim Ellett to see if those dates will work for him and for the Cow Belles.
- 5. A motion was approved to allow Project Healing Waters to purchase 20 permits for the Lease at \$15 each for use by local qualified veterans. Jim Ellett has agreed to reduce his portion to \$10.

- Speakers for the April General Meeting will be Bob Widgren giving a presentation on Atlantic Salmon fishing and for the May General meeting, Taylor Streit.
- 7. Bob Silver presented information about proposed stream improvements at the Lease. A small work party will be planned for April 28 to see if the proposed improvements are feasible. If so, a larger work party will be planned in May.
- 8. Club fishing trips were discussed as follows:
 - Chuck will ask Alex Montes to gather additional information for a trip to the Arizona reservation lakes in June.
 - Bob reported that September 29 to October 6 appears to be the most favorable dates for a trip to Kodiak, Alaska.
 - The San Juan River trip is proposed for October 18, 19 and 20.
- Tom Wobbe has received all of the prizes for the Kids' Fishing Clinic which is scheduled for April 14.
- 10. The next Board meeting will be Monday, April 16, 2012 at 7:00pm.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:10pm.

Thread: 6/0 Danville


Hook: Sz.8-16 Curved Scud/Pupa Weight: Adhesive backed lead foil Shellback: Tan 1/8 Scud Back

Rib: 5x mono

Abdomen: Any natural dubbing mixed with a synthetic such as ice dub. Color of your choice.

Thorax: Black Ostrich Herl - UV Sense

Head: Thread

There are several options for the payment of dues. A family is defined as a club member, their spouse and all children 17 years of age or under.



Lease Information

Permits to fish the Club leased waters on the Rio Peñasco can be obtained from Jim Hulsey (575-524-1880), Tom Wobbe (575-522-5437), Donna Mabie (575-522-3810) in Las Cruces and the Sportsman's Elite fly shop (915-587-4867) in El Paso. Permits can be obtained from the land owner, but you should phone (575-687-3362) the night before to ensure someone will be there to sell them to you. Permits can be ordered through the club web page (mvff.org) by filling out the form and mailing as directed. Cost is \$25.00 per day. Kids under 18 fish free but must be accompanied by an adult club member with a permit. You must be a current member of MVFF to fish the lease. Please wear your MVFF identification badge while on the property. New or replacement badges can be obtained by contacting Jim Hulsey. In addition, members can purchase a one-day, one-time permit for out of town guests.

Directions to the Lease:

Follow NM 82 east from Cloudcroft, NM or west from Artesia, NM. The turn off to the lease is located on the right side of the road about 100 yards before mile marker 54 coming from Cloudcroft or 100 yards on the left past mile marker 54 coming from Artesia.
