MVFF Board Meeting Minutes

Monday, November 15, 2010 Submitted by Jim Sorenson, Secretary

The MVFF Board meeting was called to order at 6:00pm in the NMDG&F conference room by President Bob Silver. In attendance were Bob Silver, Jim Sorenson, Chuck Mueller, Paul Turner, Jeff Arteburn, George Thomas, Gary Mann and Ron Bellerose and non-Board members Jim Hulsey and Tom Wobbe.

- 1. The Minutes of the October Board meeting were approved as published in the November newsletter.
- 2. The Treasurer's report was approved. The club has \$11,697 in available funds and \$11,003 in the Mabie Scholarship.
- 3. Tom Wobbe reported there are 216 current members, an increase of 16.
- 4. Ron Bellerose reported that Chuck Mueller conducted a casting clinic for 5 Project Healing Waters soldiers from White Sands Missile Range. Chuck needs volunteers to take them to the lease on Saturday, November 20.
- 5. A report from the ad hoc committee that was appointed to decide on raffle prizes for the annual banquet was received. The club will purchase two additional rods from Winston and two from Sage. A motion to include in the raffle a float trip on the headwaters of the Rio Grande

from Wolf Creek Anglers at a cost to the Club of \$400 was approved. In addition, George Thomas will invite Mike McCormick from Wolf Creek Anglers to make a presentation at the February or March general meeting of the Club.

- 6. The program for the December general meeting will include a presentation on the 2010 Kodiak trip, a short presentation regarding the new trap range at the Butterfield Shooting Range and the election of Board members for 2011.
- Ti Piper has asked the Club for help in putting on a Kids Fishing Clinic for special needs children on November 17-19 at Alumni Pond. Tom Wobbe will send an email soliciting volunteers.
- Arrangements for the Club's annual meeting and banquet on January 22, 2011 were reviewed. It was decided to order three pans of green and two pans of red enchiladas and 45 pounds of barbecue.
- Since John Bailey will be conducting a casting clinic in conjunction with the annual meeting, it was decided to table discussion of scheduling a casting clinic with Bob Widgren.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:45pm.

We used this fly as the dropper behind Parachute Adams and Slate Dun Parachutes. We caught around 60 fish under and around the bottom bridge. You can also tie this in gray for those slate duns. They would hit #20 to #18."

There are several options for the payment of dues. A family is defined as a club member, their spouse and all children 17 years of age or under.



Lease Information

Permits to fish the Club leased waters on the Rio Peñasco can be obtained from Jim Hulsey (575-524-1880), Tom Wobbe (575-522-5437), Donna Mabie (575-522-3810) in Las Cruces and the Sportsman's Elite fly shop (915-587-4867) in El Paso. Permits can be obtained from the land owner, but you should phone (575-687-3362) the night before to ensure someone will be there to sell them to you. Permits can be ordered through the club web page (mvff.org) by filling out the form and mailing as directed. Cost is \$25.00 per day. Kids under 18 fish free but must be accompanied by an adult club member with a permit. You must be a current member of MVFF to fish the lease. Please wear your MVFF identification badge while on the property. New or replacement badges can be obtained by contacting Jim Hulsey. In addition, members can purchase a one-day, one-time permit for out of town guests.

Directions to the Lease:

Follow NM 82 east from Cloudcroft, NM or west from Artesia, NM. The turn off to the lease is located on the right side of the road about 100 yards before mile marker 54 coming from Cloudcroft or 100 yards on the left past mile marker 54 coming from Artesia.
