The following rules will be strictly enforced for your safety and enjoyment. Violators may be disqualified from competition and/or asked to leave the premises.

Shooting Rules

- Absolutely no alcohol may be taken onto the shooting or practice ranges.
- No cigarettes, pipes or cigars may be taken onto shooting ranges due to fire hazard. Butt cans will be located at the beginning of each shooting range please deposit smoking articles in the cans before proceeding onto shooting courses!
- Non-shooters may accompany shooters onto ranges.
- Shooters under 15 years of age <u>must</u> be accompanied by an adult.
- No less than three (3) and no more than six (6) shooters in a group, please! Slower groups, please allow faster groups to "shoot through" as necessary. Be courteous!
- No rangefinders allowed on shooting ranges (including non-shooters). Binoculars allowed.
- Magnifying scopes <u>may not</u> be used except in the Open Classes.
- At least two ranges (40 targets) must be shot on Saturday. The third range may be shot on either Saturday or Sunday.
- All three ranges (A, B, and C) must be shot to be eligible for awards.
- **IMPORTANT:** Stay on the designated trails which are marked with brightly colored flagging.
- Adults (except traditional) will shoot from the yellow flags. Traditional and Youth shooters will shoot from the pink flags. Cubs will shoot from the blue flags. Pee Wees will shoot from approximately 10 feet in front of the blue Cub flag. Your body <u>must</u> touch the shooting flag.
- Shooters may begin shooting at Noon on Friday and 7:30 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday.
- Shooters <u>must</u> be off shooting ranges by 5:00 p.m. Saturday and 11:00 a.m. on Sunday.
- Each shooter will receive two scorecards. There **<u>must</u>** be two scorekeepers and one score caller in each shooting group. All scorecards **<u>must</u>** be signed and verified by shooter and scorekeepers, or scores will not be counted. If scores do not match on both scorecards, shooter will receive the <u>lowest</u> score.
- Scorecards <u>must</u> be turned in by 6:00 p.m. on Friday and Saturday. They will be reissued the next morning.
- Scoring is 12-10-8-5.
- Pass thrus will not be counted. Arrow must remain in target for a score.
- Line Hits: Arrow shaft must break into the line to receive the next higher score.
- A 2-minute time limit will be enforced to look for lost arrows. One person **<u>must</u>** stand in front of the target while other shooters search for arrows.

"All Awards must be Picked up at end of shoot"

General Rules

- <u>No early birds, check-in will start Friday at noon per Camp of the Tall Pines management.</u>
- In the event of forest closure due to fire hazard, <u>no open fires of any sort will be allowed</u>. This includes barbeque grills. We will secure a safe, centralized area where folks can use their grills.
- Please don't leave any cans, wrappers or other debris in the forest or around your campsite.
- Pack it in pack it out!
- All pets must be on leashes and kept quite after 10:30 p.m.
- Finally, we want EVERYONE to enjoy their weekend at The Camp of the Tall Pines PLEASE, turn down loud. music (and voices) after 10:30 p.m. on Saturday night. Not everyone is a night owl, so please be considerate of your neighbors. Those who do not heed this request may be asked to leave the premises, so please take it seriously! Thank You!
