Practice time will be available on Friday evening, March 6^{th} , from 6:00 - 8:30 pm. Shooting will begin **PROMPTLY** at 9:00 am on Saturday and at 8:00 am on Sunday. The second line on Saturday will begin at 1:00 pm and the second line on Sunday (if required) will begin as close to 11:00 am as we can make it. Guest shooters (non-NFAA shooters) may register and shoot on a "space available" basis. Awards will NOT be provided in the Guest shooter classes. NFAA shooters will take preference over guest shooters with regard to shooting lane availability.
