OK ---- Where's the "Alleluia"?

*Because of the penitential character of the season of Lent, singing or saying the word "Alleluia" has historically been
suspended during Lent's forty days. At the end of the worship services on February 14th, the Sunday preceding Ash
Wednesday (The Transfiguration of Our Lord), we will 'carry the "Alleluia" away'. This is the last Sunday when
alleluia will be used until Easter Sunday.*
