Christmas is coming early this year for someone. At the December General meeting, we will have the drawing for the fall rod raffle. The winner gets his or her choice of a custom made Sage fly rod—

either a 7'9" 3 weight Circa or a 9' 5 weight Accel (which was the winner of the Best Freshwater Fly Rod at the 2014 International Fly Tackle Dealer show). There is still time to buy raffle tickets.

The rod which is not selected will go into our raffle for the annual banquet. This year, we have prizes totaling nearly \$6,000 in retail value. Many thanks go to Gary Mann who has done the lion's share of the work in arranging for these prizes. Raffle tickets are \$5 each and the proceeds go to support the Club's educational and outreach programs, as well as the stocking and upkeep of the Lease.

The Club will be an exhibitor again this year at the Mesilla Valley Outdoor Expo at the Las Cruces Convention Center on January 9-11, 2015. The show hours are Friday, 1:00pm to 7:00pm; Saturday, 9:00am to 5:00pm; and Sunday, 9:00am to 4:00pm. We will need volunteers to fill three-hour time blocks on those days for the booth to talk to people about the Club and fly fishing in general and, most likely, for the kids' fishing pool run by the NM Department of Game and Fish. #### **MVFF Board Meeting Minutes**

The MVFF Board meeting was called to order at 7:00pm in the NMDG&F Conference Room by President Jim Sorenson. In attendance were Jim Sorenson, Chuck Mueller, Dennis Lanpher, Dave Medler, Bob Silver, Gary Mann, Jeff Arterburn and non-Board members Ron Bellerose, Jim Hulsey and Tom Wobbe. Representing the NMSU Chapter of the American Fisheries Society (NMSU/AFS) were Dominique Lujan and Will Lubenau.

- 1. Minutes of the October 2014 Board meeting were approved as published in the newsletter.
- 2. The treasurer's report showed a balance of \$11,421.
- 3. Tom Wobbe reported that the Club has 209 paid up members.
- 4. Ron Bellerose reported the next PHW function will be March 2015. Fly tying will continue at the local VA center.
- 5. Jeff Arterburn discussed upcoming TU meetings.
- 6. The Board discussed a possible Club meeting in El Paso in the March/ April 2015 time frame.
- 7. Dominique Lujan announced the NMSU/American Fisheries Society is planning to hold a raffle in February 2015.

- 8. The Rio Peñasco improvement project is still in the discussion stages.
- 9. Jim Sorenson presented the nominees for Board positions to be filled in the December election.
- 10. The Board discussed the possibility of adding an Ex-Officio member to the Board from the NMSU/AFS. Jim Sorenson is to research the needed changes to the MVFF by-laws.
- 11. A motion was passed for Chuck Mueller to purchase a \$375 2-person/2-day fishing trip on the San Juan from John Tavener for the upcoming banquet.
- 12. Speaker for the January 2015 meeting will be Noah Parker.
- 13. Tom Wobbe reported that to date 157 tickets for \$267 have been sold for the Fall rod raffle.
- 14. EXPO 2015 will be held at the convention center January 9-11, 2015. The Club is planning to participate. Volunteers will be needed.
- 15. The Liars & Tyers meeting for December has been cancelled because of the Holidays.
- 16. Next Board meeting will be Monday, December 15, 2014.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:20pm.

There are several options for the payment of dues. A family is defined as a club member, their spouse and all children 17 years of age or under.



#### Lease Information

Permits to fish the Club leased waters on the Rio Peñasco can be obtained from Jim Hulsey (575-524-1880), Tom Wobbe (575-522-5437) and Donna Mabie (575-522-3810) in Las Cruces. Permits can be obtained from the land owner, but you should phone (575-687-3362) the night before to ensure someone will be there to sell them to you. Permits can be ordered through the club web page (mvff.org) by filling out the form and mailing as directed. Cost is \$25.00 per day. Kids under 18 fish free but must be accompanied by an adult club member with a permit. You must be a current member (current dues have been paid) of MVFF to fish the lease. Please wear your MVFF identification badge while on the property. New or replacement badges can be obtained by contacting Jim Hulsey. In addition, members can purchase a one-day, one-time permit for out of town guests.

#### **Directions to the Lease**:

Follow NM 82 east from Cloudcroft, NM or west from Artesia, NM. The turn off to the lease is located on the right side of the road about 100 yards before mile marker 54 coming from Cloudcroft or 100 yards on the left past mile marker 54 coming from Artesia.
