Club to Match Funds

Contributions to the Norm Mabie Memorial Fund have been lagging. To get the fund moving again and to stimulate interest, the MVFF Board voted during the December meeting to use Club funds to match member donations to a total of \$1,000.

To refresh your memory, after Norm's death the Club set up a memorial fund through the NMSU Foundation. When donations total \$10,000 the fund will become endowed and will be managed by the Foundation to provide an annual scholarship for a student majoring in Fisheries or related fields. The catch is that the fund must become endowed within five years of establishment. We are currently about half way through this period. Of course, \$10,000 is only the minimum allowed. Since all earnings each year go into the scholarship a larger base fund means larger scholarships.

New Mexico Trout 2007 Conclave Saturday, 3 February

New Mexico Trout will conduct its 2007 annual Conclave on Saturday, February 3 at Sandia Prep School, 532 Osuna NE in Albuquerque from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. The program features two highly talented fly fishermen/speakers, Gary Borger and

Brad Befus; and in addition, a large raffle, youth and adult fly casting sessions and a fly tying demonstration.

Gary Borger is one of the world's foremost fly fishing educators. Since 1972 he has taught classes and lectured on all aspects of fly fishing for trout and salmon. He has written 5 best selling books on fly fishing: Nymphing, Naturals, The Borger Color System, Designing Trout Flies and Presentation. He pioneered fly fishing video instruction with his release of Nymphing in 1982. Since then, Gary has appeared in 4 videos for the 3M company and has produced over 25 videos in the "Skills of Fly Fishing Series." He has designed many innovative angling products and unique fly designs and is recognized internationally for his conservation efforts. At our conclave, he will present 3 talks: "Nymphing," Reading the Water," and "Presentation;" he will also provide a fly casting and line handling demonstration.

Brad Befus is an accomplished freshwater and saltwater angler who has fished world-wide and now

resides in Montrose, CO where he is sales manager for Ross Reels. He is an innovative fly tier with many of his patterns being produced and sold by Umpqua Feather Merchants. He has co-authored (with Barry Reynolds and John Berryman) Carp on the Fly. He has completed his second book, Techniques for Successful Fly Tying and has released three fly tying videos. Brad contributes articles and photography to many fly fishing periodicals and speaks at fly fishing and sports shows throughout the At the conclave, he will present talks entitled "Colorado's San Luis Valley," "A Taste of Western Colorado" and "The Gunnison River Basin."

He will also conduct a fly tying demonstration.

BC Hopper

The center of attention for the Liars and Tiers this month will be the *BC Hopper*.

The BC Hopper has been extolled by flytyer John Barr (designer of the *Copper John*) as very effective in a three fly setup where the top fly is the *BC Hopper*, the

second fly is a *Copper John* and the bottom fly is an emerger of some sort. Barr calls this a Hopper-Copper-Dropper rig. It is claimed to be very effective at times.



Hook: TMC 5262, size 6 Thread: Tan Monochord, 3/0 Body: Foam, 3mm thickness Kick Legs: Round rubber

Underwing: Web Wing, tan mottled Flash: Krystal Flash, root beer Overwing: Elk body hair Bullet Head: Deer hair Front Legs: Round rubber Indicator: Float-Vis, chartreuse

There are several options for the payment of dues. A family is defined as a club member, their spouse and all children 17 years of age or under.



Lease Information

Permits to fish the Club leased waters on the Rio Peñasco can be obtained from any of the Club Officers or Board Members and are also available at the *Angler's Nook*. Permits can be obtained from the land owner, but you should phone (505-687-3362) the night before to ensure someone will be there to sell them to you. Permits can be ordered through the club web page (mvff.org) by filling out the form and mailing as directed. Cost is \$20.00 per day with student permits (ages 12 through 17) costing only \$12.00 per day. Kids under 12 fish free. You must be a current member of MVFF to fish the lease. Please wear your MVFF identification badge while on the property. New or replacement badges can be obtained by contacting Jim Hulsey. In addition, members can purchase a one-day, one-time permit for out of town guests.

Directions to the Lease:

Follow NM 82 east from Cloudcroft, NM or west from Artesia, NM. The turn off to the lease is located on the right side of the road about 100 yards before mile marker 54 coming from Cloudcroft or 100 yards on the left past mile marker 54 coming from Artesia.
