

Gila-Rio Grande TU Chapter gets Grant for Agua Chiquita

The Gila-Rio Grande Chapter of TU, out of Las Cruces, has received an *Embrace-A-Stream* grant from Trout

Unlimited to work with the US Forest Service and the NM Department of Game and Fish to restore the Agua Chiquita. The overall goal of the project is to restore trout habitat on 4.8 miles of the creek. Since there is already an existing barrier at the downstream end of this section, it offers the possibility to restore Rio Grande cutthroat to the stream. If that objective is met, it would become the only stream in the Sacramentos with cutthroat, and would offer the

residents of southern New Mexico an opportunity to catch our state fish.

Mini Bow Tie Buzzer

Bow Tie Buzzers were first described in Gary Borger's *Designing Trout Flies*. The fly presented here is as modified and tied by Rick Takahashi and Jerry Hubka in their recently published book *Tying & Fishing the World's Most Effective Patterns*. If you have the book, there are step-by-step tying instructions beginning on page 52.



Hook: Tiemco 3761 or 2488, Dai-Riki 125 or 070,

size 18=26

Thread: Black 70- or 140-denier UTC

Abdomen: Tying thread

Rib: Silver Flashabou Holographic tinsel

Wing buds: Brown biot Wing case: Mirage tinsel Gills: Oral-B Ultra Floss

Coat the finished fly with Sally Hansen Hard as Nails

or Loon Outdoors UV Knot Sense.



Fishing Report

Fishing report for March 3rd on the Rio Peñasco. We started fishing around 9:30am with a nice midge and morning dun hatch lasting for about an hour. During that time I caught over twelve rainbows using a size 18 Para BWO nymph and size 20 Para red midge emerger. After that the hatch stopped and I switched to a size 12 Prince Nymph with a trailing red or green midge, size 20, with good results. I quit fishing

around 2pm after catching about 16 rainbows and 1 brown. Most of the rainbows were under 10 inches with a few larger ones. When we started fishing the temperature was about 60 and it was 78 when we finished. Over all it was a very good day to be on the Rio Peñasco.

There are several options for the payment of dues. A family is defined as a club member, their spouse and all children 17 years of age or under.



Lease Information

Permits to fish the Club leased waters on the Rio Peñasco can be obtained from Jim Hulsey (575-524-1880), Tom Wobbe (575-522-5437), Donna Mabie (575-522-3810) in Las Cruces and the Sportsman's Elite fly shop (915-587-4867) in El Paso. Permits can be obtained from the land owner, but you should phone (575-687-3362) the night before to ensure someone will be there to sell them to you. Permits can be ordered through the club web page (mvff.org) by filling out the form and mailing as directed. Cost is \$25.00 per day. Kids under 18 fish free but must be accompanied by an adult club member with a permit. You must be a current member of MVFF to fish the lease. Please wear your MVFF identification badge while on the property. New or replacement badges can be obtained by contacting Jim Hulsey. In addition, members can purchase a one-day, one-time permit for out of town quests.

Directions to the Lease:

Follow NM 82 east from Cloudcroft, NM or west from Artesia, NM. The turn off to the lease is located on the right side of the road about 100 yards before mile marker 54 coming from Cloudcroft or 100 yards on the left past mile marker 54 coming from Artesia.
